## CHILDREN'S MINISTRY CHANGES

Effective August 1, age levels in our nurseries and children's churches will be redistributed. The age levels we have in place need to be "tweaked" from time to time because of varying ages of children who flow through our ministry. This allows us to continue to provide age appropriate environments for our kids and to minister more effectively to each age bracket. The changes are as follows:

- **Infant Nursery:** 0 to 24 months
- **Toddler Nursery:** Ages 2 & 3
- **KUC Jr Children's Church:** Ages 4,5, & 6
- **KUC Children's Church:** Ages 7 through 12

Any child who is 3 before August 1, and already established in KUC Jr., will not be moved back. The same goes for any child who is 6 and already established in KUC.

Thank you for for working with us on this. It's not a huge change, but it helps us tremendously as we try to keep our class size ratios where they need to be and our curriculum on an age appropriate level.
